

To the Osa!

Cloud Forest, Rain Forest, Hiking, Birding, Wildlife, Beaches, Culture!
On this 9-day trip you will have a bilingual naturalist guide/driver for 3 days in order to visit interesting places in the mountains on your way down to the Osa Peninsula.

Day 1

Welcome to Costa Rica!

An ACTUAR driver will meet your flight and take you to a charming B&B in San José.

Day 2

To the cloud forest!

Your bilingual, naturalist guide will pick you up at your hotel and take you to El Toucanet in Copey de Dota. Explore the cloud forest with your guide. That night, enjoy a delicious dinner of freshly caught trout.

Day 3

Quetzals and culture

Before breakfast, your guide will take you hiking in search of the beautiful Resplendent Quetzal, the sacred bird of the Maya. The quetzal cannot live in captivity. It is only found in old-growth forests at high altitudes. It is an inspiring sight, with its long, graceful tail feathers, iridescent green plumage and red chest. After breakfast, your guide will take you about 3 hours south to BriBri Pa Kaneblo in the BriBri Salitre Indigenous Territory near Buenos Aires, in Costa Rica's southern zone. The elders will greet you in their native language and take you on a walk through their rainforest reserve, telling about the uses of the plants, and showing you native customs along the way. Overnight at BriBri Pa Kaneblo.

Day 4

To the Osa!

After a relaxed breakfast visit a local indigenous home. Then your guide will take you in about 2.5 hours to Puerto Jiménez on the gulf side of the Osa Peninsula. There you will be picked up by Bosque del Cabo Lodge, one of the ecolodges that made the Osa famous, and taken to their lovely bungalows overlooking the ocean.

Round trip transfer from Puerto Jiménez to Bosque del Cabo

Day 5

Wildlife!

Hike in Corcovado National Park with a local guide, arranged by Bosque del Cabo (optional), or just hang out in Bosque's rainforest reserve, which has four kinds of monkeys and many other animals that are also found in Corcovado.

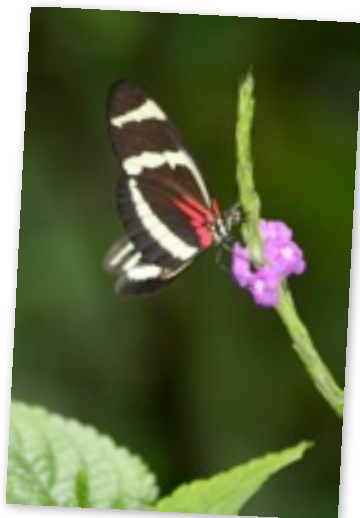
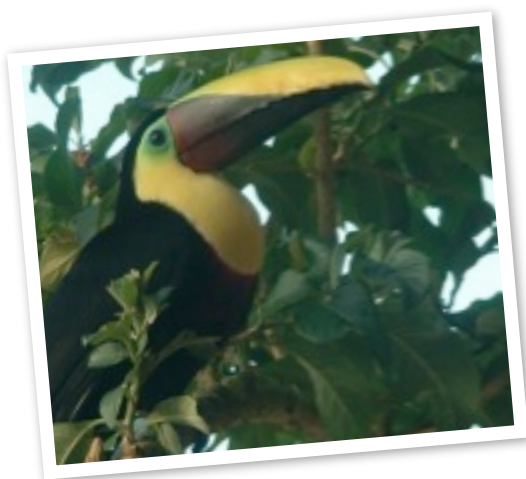
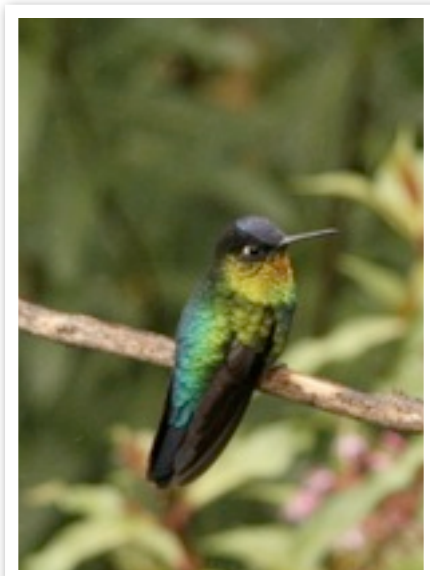
Transfer to airport
